

Tbird Covid-19 Return to Sport Procedures Quick Guide

From everyone here at Thunderbird Show Park, we want to thank you for your support in the following protocols as the health and safety of our clients, staff and community is paramount.

Before you Arrive

- 1 Contact Tracing forms need to be filled out and emailed to shauna@tbird.ca To maintain proper distancing on the grounds we are limiting the amount of people on the grounds to 2 people per horse
- 2 Please log into your SGL account to ensure you are linked correctly to your entries. Once logged into your account you should see your entries (anything you are listed as the owner, trainer or rider on) on the left hand side of the screen under 'my entries'.
- 3 Masks. Everyone must wear a mask at all times unless mounted, as well as being optional in your barn area and at your RV Site. Please bring your own mask(s) with you.
- 4 Symptom free. If you are experiencing any of the Covid-19 Symptoms you will need to report that immediately to your local health officials.
- 5 Please bring your own tools and tack to eliminate any un-needed sharing of equipment (hoses, tack, forks, wheelbarrows)

Upon Arrival

- 1 Temperature checks will be done every time anyone enters onto the grounds. Please use the exhibitor entrance on 72nd Avenue and proceed to one of the two temperature and contact list checking stations. Upon confirmation of both, you will be given a wrist band for the week for your grounds access contact checklist, and then it will only be the temperature checks going forward.
- 2 Stabling allocation will be posted online (tbird.ca and tbird social sites) and will be done with spacing and exits in mind so that each barn will not have to stable facing another barn, or walk down another barns aisle way if possible. To assist in this, we will place fencing at the end of each barns row to have a physical barrier as well.
- 3 Collecting Numbers – once a barn has been verified as having all their memberships and e-signatures done, the trainer may come to the 'walk up window' (located inside the indoor arena) to collect all the numbers all at once

During the Rendezvous

- 1 Warm up Rings will be limited to 2 people (on the ground) per the amount of jumps in that particular warm up ring (ie 3 oxers = 6 people at a time). We will have stewards at the entrance to each individual warm up ring and they will keep count of the people walking in the ring, as well, they will give each person walking out hand sanitizer.
- 2 Horses will not be limited in the warm up or hacking arena's. Please avoid walking side by side another rider in any ring or on the grounds.

- 3 No spectators will be allowed on the grounds and all mass seating options will be removed. (Bleachers, chairs, hospitality furniture)
- 4 We will have numerous staff ensuring compliance to social distancing rules around the rings, barns and grounds.
- 5 Barns that have 15+ horses will have a portable washroom provided at no extra charge and will be cleaned daily by our custodial staff.
- 6 Hand wash stations will be spread around the grounds and we ask you to use them frequently.
- 7 Showgrounds Live has enabled us to alleviate congestion points at course board, the office and ingates as the daily class sign ups are completely digital as the courses will also be posted on SGL. The office will remain closed except for the walk up window (from the indoor arena) but we will be staffed to be able to answer all of your questions and help you with SGL on the office phone line.
- 8 Wash Racks – hand wash stations will be placed at all wash racks so that you can wash your hands before AND after using the wash racks.
- 9 Shower facilities will be closed.
- 10 Please avoid visiting other stabling areas other than your own.
- 11 Golf carts will be limited to one person per cart at all times, unless a caretaker of under aged children. Drivers are required to hold a valid driver’s license. Please email greensidegolfcarts@gmail.com for rentals.

Closing Out

- 1 Closing out your bill will now be done online or easily done on the ShowGroundsLive app, we are always available to help guide you through this process via phone or email and please let us know if you see any discrepancies

SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES
